

2010 HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW SHOW CLASSES

Showing on the Flat – Conditions of Entry

Qualifying Shows: All New Zealand A & P Shows, Pukahu Show (Hastings), New Zealand National Horse & Pony Show (Dannevirke), Taranaki All Breeds Show (Stratford), New Zealand Grand National Show (Christchurch), Manawatu & Districts Horse and Pony Breeders Show (Feilding), North Island Premier Showing Championships (Hamilton), Kyrewood Equestrian Centre Ltd Variety Horse Show (Palmerston North), Manawatu Showing Championships (Feilding), Waikato Showing Championships (Hamilton), Hawkes Bay Showing Championships (Hastings)

1. All classes will be run under the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ Rules and Regulations for A&P Shows unless otherwise stated.
2. All entries qualifying after closing date, a late entry will be considered.
Note: If a late entry is accepted, the entrant will start first in the title classes.
3. All entries must be in the name of the owner/rider who will be riding at the show. The age of all riders is as at the 1st January 2010.
4. All competitors entering title classes for the competition must have been a New Zealand resident six months preceding the first day of 2010 HOY competition. However, if a competitor has extenuating circumstances regarding residency, the Show Committee will consider each competitor's circumstances on a case-by-case basis.
5. The Show Committee will endeavour to run to the start times as listed in the programme but reserve the right to amend times because of circumstances beyond their control. Rings may be split to allow more than one class to run at a time. A competitor must be prepared to enter the ring at the stated time for the section they are competing in.
6. All matters relating to protests or disciplinary action will be referred to Equestrian Sports New Zealand (ESNZ). The general conditions of the Horse Of The Year (HOY) also cover the showing section. Protests must be lodged, at the office of the Showing Secretary, within 15 minutes of the completion of the class together with a deposit of \$50.
7. The Senior Steward in charge may, at his/her discretion, transfer an entry to its appropriate class where it is found to be incorrectly entered. The Showing Secretary's office is to be advised accordingly.
8. ESNZ membership cards must be carried at all times. Competitors not carrying their membership card will forfeit any prize won if they leave the ring to get their card. **Leading Rein, First Ridden and Led In Hand classes are exempt.**
9. Height certificates must be carried at all times and be presented upon request by an official. Competitors not carrying their height certificate will forfeit any prize won if they leave the ring to get their certificate.
10. For age group classes (led In Hand pony & show horse), competitors must attach a photocopy of registration, veterinary certificate or other means to verify the age of horse/pony to the entry form.
11. A rider may only compete in the section that he/she is nominated to compete in at the beginning of the season, i.e. first show he/she competed in after 1st October 2009. Once the horse/pony has achieved 6

wins in conformation classes, it will not be eligible to return to “Novice” status should it change sections at the beginning of a new show season.

12. A substitution of a horse/pony will be permitted on the condition that the horse/pony being substituted takes no further part in the show. A substituted horse/pony must be of the same age/height class and owned by the same owner. Veterinarian certificates will not be required. Substitutions must be made 24 hours before the class begins.
13. Australian performances will be accepted for qualification.
14. The qualification of horses/ponies for the Lead Up open classes and Lead Up Rising Star classes is not required.
15. Entries for most of the open title classes must have won one Champion or two Reserve Champions from an Open Conformation class in the section you have competed in at one of the qualifying shows in the twelve months prior to the first day of 2010 HOY competition. A Champion or Reserve Champion, gained by qualifying through a Novice champion win or a restricted class, is not acceptable. Wins in unit classes for Riding or Paced & Mannered or Conformation are not acceptable. However, there are exceptions to this rule 15 so please refer to the ‘schedule of classes’ for qualification details.
16. Rising Star horses and ponies may not compete in the open ring except for the Working Hunter Horse; Working Hunter Pony; Gee Wizz; Adult Rider classes; Child Rider classes; Wonder Memorial; Side Saddle; NZ Bred Ponies and NZRPS classes. To compete in the Rising Star section, a Rising Star is classed as a horse or pony not to have won an Open Champion before HOY 2009 in any section excluding Leading Rein and First Ridden. A horse/pony is eligible if it has won an Open Championship in the 2008 - 2009 season.
17. All exhibits in ridden classes must be either fillies, mares or geldings 3yrs and over. No stallions to be ridden in the showing section.
18. All horses/ponies shown in hand must have a suitable halter or bridle with a fastened throat lash. Entire males 2 years and over must be controlled by a bit.
19. Breastplate number holders are **compulsory** for all classes and the competitor is responsible for making the number. Working hunters are **exempt** for safety reasons and back numbers will be provided by HOY available from 1.00pm Monday 15th March 2010 from the showing secretary located in the large hospitality/officials tent in the showing area.
20. If a horse/pony misbehaves to the extent that it unduly disturbs other competitors, it must leave the arena if requested to do so by the steward or judge.
21. All horses or ponies must be in the holding area before title classes commence.
22. Only ponies that are novice status may be ridden by adults in Rising Star classes.
23. No electronic devices to be worn in the ring or holding area.
24. No tongue-ties or artificial transparent head restraints to be used in any ridden classes.
25. No bandages or boots to be worn in the ring.
26. All exhibitors with the exception of foals & yearlings must be presented in a bitted bridle. The bit must be in its manufactured condition.

27. All Lapels/Badges are banned from being worn on show jackets

Scoring

The scoring system for the title classes will be judged by three independent judges of which the combination of the two highest rankings will determine the final placings of that class.

In the event of a tie, the final placings for the following classes will be determined by:

- Conformation – Conformation mark
- Paces and Manners – Manners mark
- Jumping – Jump mark
- Leading Rein & First Ridden – Suitability & Safety mark
- Riding – Consultation between three judges

- All ponies to walk and trot in company and maybe asked to canter in an individual workout. Riders that have competed in the equivalent of an Open Pony section may not compete in First Ridden classes with the exception of a show that does not provide a First Ridden section then it is permissible for the pony and rider to compete in the Open Section at that show only. Refer to RAS Rule book Page 23 Rule 57) 1.e
- Must be single rein only and no spurs.
- A whip with a flapper 4cm long and 2cm wide, total length 68cm or a small cane may be carried.
- Competitors may not compete in open showing classes including the Wonder Memorial.
