### MOUNTED GAMES RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**Please read and sign as entries not correct at closing date will be returned to sender and put on a waiting list as for a late entry**

1. All competitors and persons responsible must ensure they read and agree to the General Conditions for the HOY show as per the website [www.hoy.co.nz](http://www.hoy.co.nz) (including drug testing requirements).
2. **LATE ENTRIES** will only be accepted to fill existing heats and will be subject to a 20% penalty. This will be strictly adhered to this year. **Late entries OR entries not correctly filled out** may not be accepted and will be placed on a waiting list in case of scratchings.
3. The organisers reserve the right to limit entries in any one particular class if necessary, even if entries are received before the closing date. Entries not accepted under these circumstances will be placed first on a waiting list in case of scratchings.
4. Age of riders as at 01/07/2011.
5. Riders competing must be current financial members of NZMGA. This will be checked and entries will not be accepted if not current financial members.
6. Each individual must provide AT LEAST 1 helper to assist with equipment/assistant referee or other work. Each team must provide AT LEAST two helpers. Each individual or team's helpers to assist with equipment for the heats in which the team/individual is competing, and in the heat following. Individuals or teams may be "fined" 5 points on each occasion on which they do not have a helper on duty when required or if the competition is delayed due to lack of helpers.
7. Additional helpers will be needed and volunteers over and above the conditions printed above will be very much appreciated.
8. Competitions will be run under International Mounted Games Association rules 2010 edition. Competitors must be conversant with the rules which are available at <http://www.mounted-games.org/imga/>
9. A representative of the rider/team **must** be present at the rider briefing.
10. A team consists of 4 or 5 riders.
11. Standard approved safety helmets must be worn (see IMGA rules) and NZMGA strongly recommends the use of NZ Pony Club Association currently approved helmets ([www.nzpca.org](http://www.nzpca.org))
12. There will be 8 races in each session and 10 races in the finals. Points will accumulate over the 3 sessions. Where there are more than 6 individuals or teams in a class, overall points will be used to allocate riders to particular finals. The 6 riders with the most points at the end of session 3 will compete in the A Final, the next 6 riders will compete in the B Final etc.
13. The number of finals may be limited for any reason and will be decided by the organisers. There will be a maximum of 3 finals per class (A, B, C only).
14. Points for each final will start at zero.
15. When a class has 6 or fewer individuals or teams, then a fourth session will be run instead of a final with points accumulating.
16. The organisers reserve the right to limit the number of entries or to alter the programme for any reason, including weather and ground conditions.
17. Each rider under 18 years of age must have a parent/guardian/caregiver present at the games arena, while they are competing.
18. HEIGHT CERTIFICATES. Mounts are required to be 15hh and under, as per IMGA rules. It is the organising committee's decision that on the day of competition that a mount considered to be over this limit shall be measured and if found over the 15hh requirement shall be withdrawn from competition, unless a current RAS Height Certificate is produced.
19. If only 1 team is entered in a class, that class will be combined with another class. If there are 2 entries, the class will be run, but no rugs will be presented. 3 or more team entries in the class will run, with rugs presented to the winning team.

**MOUNTED GAMES RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY (contin)**

20. A pony may be entered only ONCE in classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 and ONCE in classes 7, 8, 9.

21. Yards will be available ONLY to ponies entered and competing in mounted games at the show (ie no "spare" ponies or ponies for sale). There will be only 1 mount per 1 yard, if riders have mounts in other sections at the show they must source yards from the appropriate organisers. Local ponies will be allocated yards only if available.

22. Yards will be allocated on a first-in-first served basis once correct entries have been received.

23. Competitors or Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate legislation, NZMGA Inc/IMGA rules and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992. Each competitor/exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the event.

**Declaration:** I am the Exhibitor and /or Competitor of the horse/pony stated on this for/at the stated event. I understand that neither the Organising Committee of the above event; nor NZMGA Inc; nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts liability for any accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whether caused by the negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. I am the owner of the horse/pony or his/her authorised agent and have been authorised by the owner to make this entry. I certify that I have read and understand and will abide by the Rules and Conditions printed on this schedule and that my horse/pony is eligible for any class we are competing in.

**Consent:** I consent to the terms of the Privacy Act 1993 to the information on this form being used by the Organising Committee and the NZMGA Inc for all purposes connected with the administration of NZMGA Inc equestrian sport in New Zealand. I also consent to the collection of these entry details by NZ Horse of the Year for entry purposes and the use and disclosure of this information to sponsors and other agencies as required.
