**Conditions of Entry**

1. This section is for Pinto coloured horses only. Horses MUST be correctly registered & the owner a current financial member of the NZ Pinto Horse Society Inc. at date of win, otherwise win does not count
2. **QUALIFICATION** - All horses (excluding foals) entering the Title classes must have won a Champion Pinto, Reserve Champion Pinto or Best Registered Pinto at a Qualification show between 1st January 2014 & 22nd February 2015 i.e. you must have won a Champion, Reserve or Best Registered Inhand Pinto to enter the Inhand Title class and a Champion, Reserve OPEN Pinto or Best Registered Ridden Pinto to enter the Ridden Title class. All other classes do NOT require qualification
3. **ATTENDANCE** - All horses (excluding foals) entering the Pinto section MUST have competed at a minimum of two (2) RAS qualifying shows (excluding HOY 2014) in a Pinto section or if no Pinto section is run then another showing section held at the show is acceptable between 1st March 2014 & 1st March 2015
4. Qualifying Shows are ALL RAS affiliated shows, NZ National Showcase Championships and North & South Island Pinto Shows
5. The Pinto section Qualification form (Certificate of Qualification) is to be completed & sent to the NZ Pinto Society Secretary by 1st March 2015. The form also available at [www.nzpinto.com](http://www.nzpinto.com)
6. Novice Pony/Horse has not won 6 or more 1st in a Ridden conformation class or Best Registered Ridden Pinto class by 22nd February 2015
7. Open Ponies can only be ridden by riders 17 years and under. Adults can ride Novice Ponies in Best Presented, Rider and Novice classes only. Competitors riding a pony must be in child's attire – no long boots, chaps or gaiters
8. Riders under 17 years must wear a safety riding helmet with the harness attached to the shell of the helmet at more than two points at ALL TIMES when mounted on the show grounds
9. Lead rein is not eligible for the ridden classes
10. Breastplate number holders or armbands are compulsory and the competitor is responsible for making the number. Only black numbers on a white background are acceptable
11. All Colts/Stallions over 6 months of age must be shown in a bridle and bit. Miniature Horses must be shown in a halter and chain. All Colts/Stallions regardless of age must display a "S" Stallion badge on the halter or bridle at all times. Colts/stallions will be eliminated with no refund given if Stallion badge is not attached. An attendant 18 years or over in addition to the handler/rider to remain on standby at all times. If a Stallion/colt is unruly they will be asked to leave the ring immediately. Handler must be 18 years or over and rider must be 15 years or over
12. **Definitions**  
Show Horse A quality elegant horse possessing the conformation, soundness, manners and paces of a show horse  
Saddle Hunter Handsome with substance. A weight carrying animal capable of carrying his rider with ease and safety over longer distance with controlled, forward energy and strong, easy paces
13. In the Pinto Horse over 148cm section you can enter either Show Horse or Saddle Hunter not both with the same horse
14. No entries accepted on the day
15. Any spectators, horses or competitors found mistreating a horse, competing a horse deemed to be lame by the judge. Arguing/fighting, disturbing other competitors or being abusive to other competitors, judges or officials will be eliminated with no refund and must leave the area immediately
16. All competitors must abide by the HOY Show regulations, conditions and RAS Rules including height certificates, age of horse and handler/rider, unless specific ruling is stated above
